

## Edith Whiteman Memorial Prize for Most Painterly Use of Fiber in a Garment or Work of Art

First Prize: \$100.00 (given by Serena Rachels)

Two Second Prizes: \$50.00 each (given by Chantal Loeb, EW's granddaughter)

To be awarded at the Finger Lakes Fiber Arts Festival, Sept. 2011

1. An original work, wearable or not, which embodies the painterly use of fiber, in which the aesthetic principles of color and design are significant. 90% of the work must be in fiber.
  2. One submission per person, completed in the last year.
  3. Persons submitting an entry do NOT have to be members of any guild.
  4. The work must be complete in itself, not part of a series to be completed or a work-in-progress.
  5. Not a kit, not a copy or adaptation of another person's previous work or pattern
  6. These entries will be part of the Skein and Garment Contest, and as such, must include a \$2.00 entry fee and comply with all the rules of the Skein and Garment Competition (The rules for S&G will be posted shortly at <http://www.gvhg.org/fest/s&g.html>).
  7. Work must be postmarked or handed in at the guild meeting by September 1, 2011.
  8. All entries must come with a \$2.00 submission fee and a 3X5 card indicating the maker's name, address, phone number and email address (if available). This card will be covered so that it will not be visible during judging. If you wish to include more information (handspun, hand-dyed, no commercial yarn used, etc.) please type out the info and attach it to the work.
  9. Anyone not following these requirements will be eliminated without exception.
  10. All works must be picked up by 3:30-4 pm Sunday, Sept. 18, 2011 at the Fiber Festival site. If this is not possible, the artist must designate an agent who will pick up the work for him/her on that day. The artist can also prepay return postage and supply packaging to return the item to him/her. If none of these actions is taken, items become the property of GVHG.
